### Acceptable Heavy Trash/Bulk/Yard Waste Collection – Place at the Curb by 7 a.m.

Heavy Trash/Bulk/Yard Waste - 2 appliances or bulky items and 25 bags/bundles of yard waste per collection

- Furniture and Mattresses.
- Grills Must be emptied of ash or briquettes no propane tanks.
- Household appliances
  - Refrigerators must have Freon removed and must be tagged by a certified technician.
  - Hot water heaters must be drained.
- Yard Waste and Live Christmas Trees
  - Bush and tree trimmings must be cut in lengths not to exceed 4 feet, no greater than 2 inches in diameter and tied in bundles not to exceed 35 pounds.
  - Grass clippings and leaves must be bagged.
- Cardboard Boxes Must be broken down flat.
- Packing peanuts Must be bagged. Drivers will not clean up packing peanut spills.
